



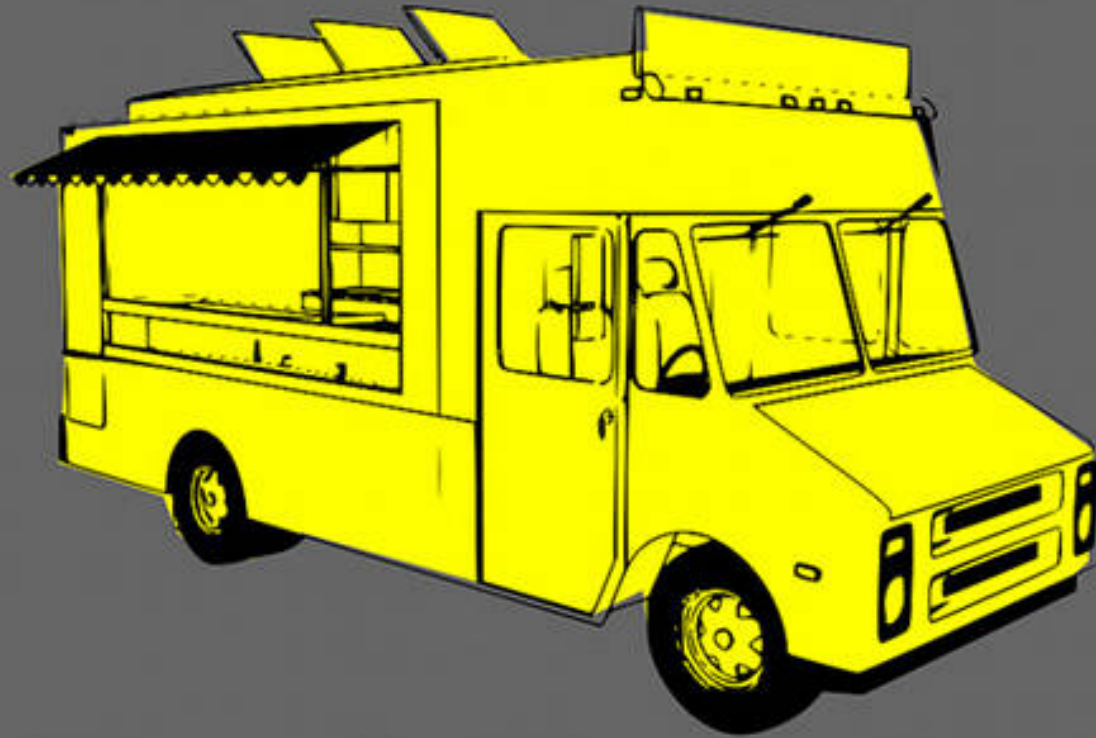

I'm pretty sure; most of you have drooled watching Eat Street, the popular show that features awesome food from food trucks all around America.

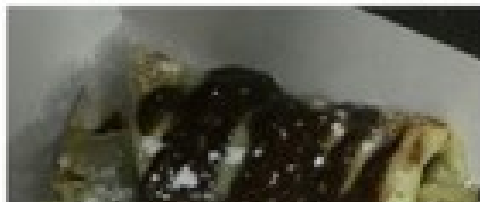
Well, here Salt and Sandals brings you the five hottest food trucks from all around Delhi NCR. We reckon, have a go!
